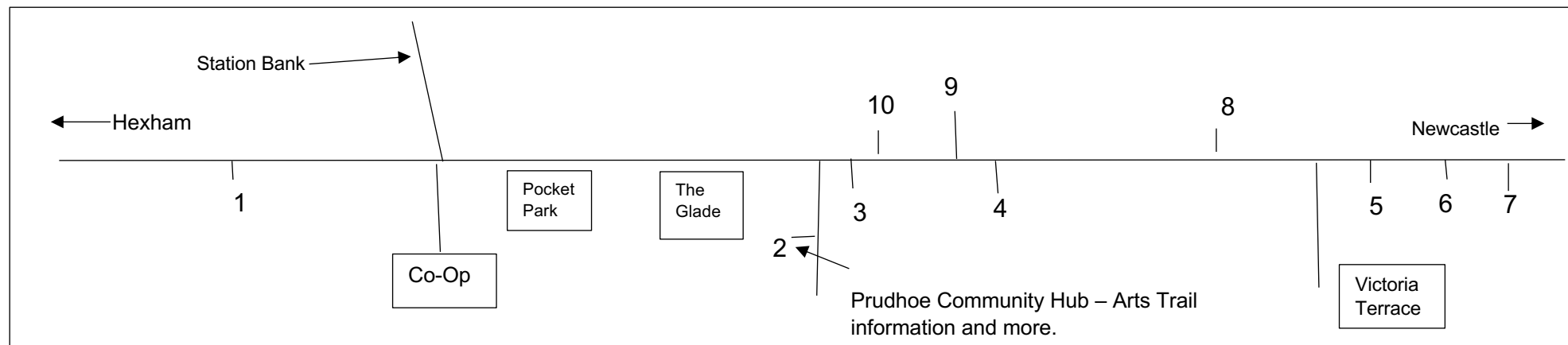


## Front Street, Prudhoe. Map of participating shops and businesses
